Handling over 3 million tonnes a year of ferrous material the recycling business is a significant contributor to the raw material requirements of the steel industry and provides a sustainable alternative to landfill, capturing the full value in use of the materials recycled.

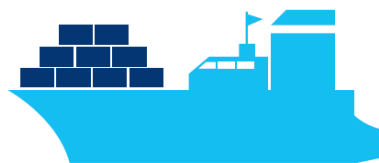
The business' experience in international non-ferrous trading and marketing, key relationships with consumers as well as local market knowledge

Expanding on the well-established Australasian footprint and knowledge base, the Alliance is developing its network of suppliers as well as advanced collection and processing facilities for both ferrous and non-ferrous metals across the UK, USA and continental Europe. It plans to use locally sourced ferrous scrap metal to supply Liberty Steels' its electric arc furnaces and steel mills with feedstock to manufacture and distribute new steel products through our downstream businesses and supply-chain expertise. The sustainability of this fully integrated GREENSTEEL approach will be further enhanced in the future by use and investment in renewable energy.
